#### **OEAB Boundaries**

- ✓ ~Understand FY15-16
- ✓ Advise on FY17
- Advise on FY18+
- Assist the OER in development of a 5 year plan
- ✓ Review (annually): **proposal review process**
- Other assistance as Administrator requests
- $\checkmark$  Comply with FACA rules

#### **Administrator Requests**

- Focus first on the NOAA OER areas for discovery
  OER = OKEANOS + OET + ECS + Competitive Grants
- Consider Administrator's priorities:
  - OE must support NOAA mission requirements
  - Exploration results must lead to "actionable environmental information" for NOAA clients

Note: We will get to other agencies and institutes in due course



### **NOAA OE Program Funding**

- Approximate Funding:
  - FY 13: \$23.688 million
  - FY 14: \$26.0 million
  - FY15 : \$28.0 million
  - FY16: \$32.0 million (Omnibus Appropriation)
  - FY17: probably done
  - FY18: already in early formulation
