OEAB Boundaries

- Advise the Administrator on priority areas for survey/ discovery
 - Understand FY15-16
 - Advise on FY17 +
- Assist the OER in development of a 5 year plan
- Review (annually): proposal review process
- Other assistance as Administrator requests
- Comply with FACA rules



Administrator Requests

- Focus first on the NOAA OER areas for discovery
 - OER = OKEANOS +OET + ECS + Competitive Grants
- Consider Administrator's priorities:
 - OE must support NOAA mission requirements
 - Exploration results must lead to "actionable environmental information" for NOAA clients

Note: We will get to other agencies and institutes in due course



NOAA OE Program Funding

Approximate Funding:

- FY 13: \$23.688 million
- FY 14: \$26.0 million
- FY15: \$28.0 million
- FY16: \$19.334 million (President's Budget Request)
- FY17: in formulation now



FY 15 OER Funding Breakdown \$28.0 M Appropriated

- NOAA overhead is \$1.8 M
- OER office cost is \$1.0 M
- Investments by Function: \$25.2 M
 - Science and Technology \$ 7.7 M
 - Expeditions\$ 13.8 M
 - Education\$ 1.9 M
 - Data Management \$ 1.8 M



FY 15 OER Funding Breakdown \$28.0 M Appropriated

By "Discovery Activity"*	\$ 17.1 M	
– Okeanos Explorer	\$	5.6 M
OET/Nautilus	\$	4.2 M
– Charters (ECS, BOEM)	\$	2.2 M
 Grants and CIs 	\$	5.1 M
