



Explorer-in-Training (EiT) Program



Expedition-Based

- ~2-4 week, ocean mapping internship aboard NOAA Ship *Okeanos Explorer*
- Gain hands-on experience, learn the foundations of data acquisition and processing, and life at sea


Shore-Based

- 10-week summer internship
- Remote and/or in person (DC area)
- Work with mentors on research projects supporting NOAA Ocean Exploration mission areas



Programmatic Growth

- Addition of 10-week summer internship track in 2020
- Hired full-time Internship Program
 Coordinator
- Collaboration with Smithsonian
 National Museum of Natural History
- 994 EiT applications in FY 24, 600% increase since FY 22





Internship Experience

Activities/Programming

- <u>10-Week Interns:</u>
 - Orientation: Intro to OER
 - Final report and presentation
 - NOAA Ocean Exploration
 Internship Symposium
- Expedition-based EiTs:
 - Welcome Meeting: Travel/expedition logistics
 - $\circ~$ Final report to UCAR

Professional Development

- <u>OER</u>: Focus on ocean exploration topics, career paths, staff/former intern panels
- <u>USM/TU/JSU</u>: Job skills, study design, scientific presentations, resumes, etc.
- <u>NOAA OAR</u>: Focus on NOAA resources, career paths, Sr. Leadership coffee chats
- <u>GEO-REU</u> and <u>USGS</u>: Interns invited to join as interested and available




Impacts - Student Feedback



- 170 Explorers-in-Training since 2009
- Exit survey/interview results show:
 - High satisfaction with experience
 - Increased knowledge of the deep sea
 - Increased understanding of NOAA and career paths in ocean exploration
- Working to develop PRA-approved surveys to standardize feedback across interns



Alumni - Where Are They Now?



~65% pursued graduate degrees or work
as scientists, technicians, research
professors, educators, and leaders in
various federal agencies, academic
institutions, non-profit organizations, etc.

- ~15% have stayed in ocean exploration
- 3 joined NOAA Ocean Exploration as federal or contract employees
- Standardize longitudinal tracking to collect consistent metrics



Future Directions

- **Direct Hire Authority (DHA) eligibility** for 10-week EiTs through the 21st Century Conservation Service Corps Act of 2019 (CCA)
- Improve equity in EiT application review and selection process
- Improve diversity in EiT applicants through targeted advertising
- **Promote cohesion** within and across OER and OECI intern cohorts





Future Directions Cont'd

- Standardize OER intern experience:
 - Intern handbook, guidance, work plan templates
 - Mentor support and resources
 - Seafloor mapping curriculum for expedition-based EiTs

• Program expansion:

- Support additional EiTs by building partnerships with other NOAA programs and external organizations
- Build deep-sea capacity for regional partners with targeted internship opportunities – modeled after EiT, but tailored to meet regional and community needs
